Centennial Camporee: The Erie Shores Council Centennial Camporee will be held at beautiful Maumee Bay State Park, 1400 State Park Road, Oregon, OH, 43618. The Camporee Committee sends an open invitation to all Scouts, Scouters, Ventures and Webelos to camp and Cub Scouts to attend on Saturday. Cubs and Webelos are encouraged to participate, even though there are no specific Cub activities. Out of Council units are welcome. The Centennial Camporee will be the Weekend of October 8-10, 2010 and will be jammed packed with fun things to do and see.

This year marks the 100th year of scouting in the United States. The Camporee will be held around the inland lake area of the state park. Units will camp together in designated areas of the picnic grounds. Areas will be assigned using jamboree style and pre-registration is strongly recommended. Each unit is to provide their own food, cooking stoves and shelter. Please indicate, with the registration, if you wish to camp near a certain troop. Efforts will be made to accommodate your request, when possible.

Celebrating 100 years of Scouting in America: The Centennial Camporee will be filled with scheduled activities and displays of history, service and Scouting. Enjoy yourself by visiting displays from the military, parks and recreation, among others, or, you can observe demonstrations of Scuba, LNT and chain saw carving. Experience history by challenging yourself at Scout Skills, or step into the present and the future with geocaching, Amateur Radio and Disability Awareness. There are more activities planned than one can possibly visit. Come out and have fun, you may learn something new along the way!

Registration: Register by completing the enclosed form or complete online at: toledobsa.org and mail in to address below. Campsites will be set up based on pre-registration numbers, so register early and include all your scouts and scouters who will be attending. Cost of the weekend is \$15.00 per person. Checks should be made out to Boy Scouts, and mailed to: Erie Shores Council #460, BSA, P.O. Box 8728, Toledo OH 43623.

Check-in: The excitement begins when you use the main entrance to the park via the Curtis Road. (**Please do not arrive prior to 6 PM.**) Follow the signs to the campground (left fork) until you reach the security (check in) station. At this point all units will be directed to the parking and unloading area. Unit equipment trailers will be separated at the security checkpoint and be dropped off in an assigned area for delivery by Camporee staff to the campsite. These unit vehicles will then continue to parking area to join their unit. Units will park and unload personal gear. The SPL and SM will report to the registration desk and will then be directed to the unit campsite. Pertinent information will be shared upon your arrival and time will be allowed for set-up. **Completed troop roster and payment are to be turned in here before unit is taken to campsite.**

Leaders Meeting

Friday night following the opening camp program, a Leaders meeting will be held in the amphitheater for the SPL and SM. Schedule and site limitations will be shared. Be sure a representative from the unit attends this important meeting.

First Aid

Medical services will be available through the first aid site, however, minor injuries requiring band aid type needs are to be handled by the troop. Scout medications are the responsibility of the troop and Scoutmaster.

Cooking and Ground Fires: During this weekend, ground fires will not be permitted. Cooking stoves will be necessary for food preparation as no food will be available for purchase.

Religious Services: There will be an ecumenical service on Saturday evening. Separate religious services will be held for Catholics. There is a Catholic Church nearby, but plans are to have a priest conduct mass on site.

Departure: When you arrive and camp and check in with the Registration Table, you will be given a receipt. Hand this receipt to your district representative at checkout for your campsite inspection. Upon successful inspection of your site, the district person will sign the receipt and turn it in for you, thus approving you for departure. All campsites will be approved and cleared by 11:00 AM on Sunday

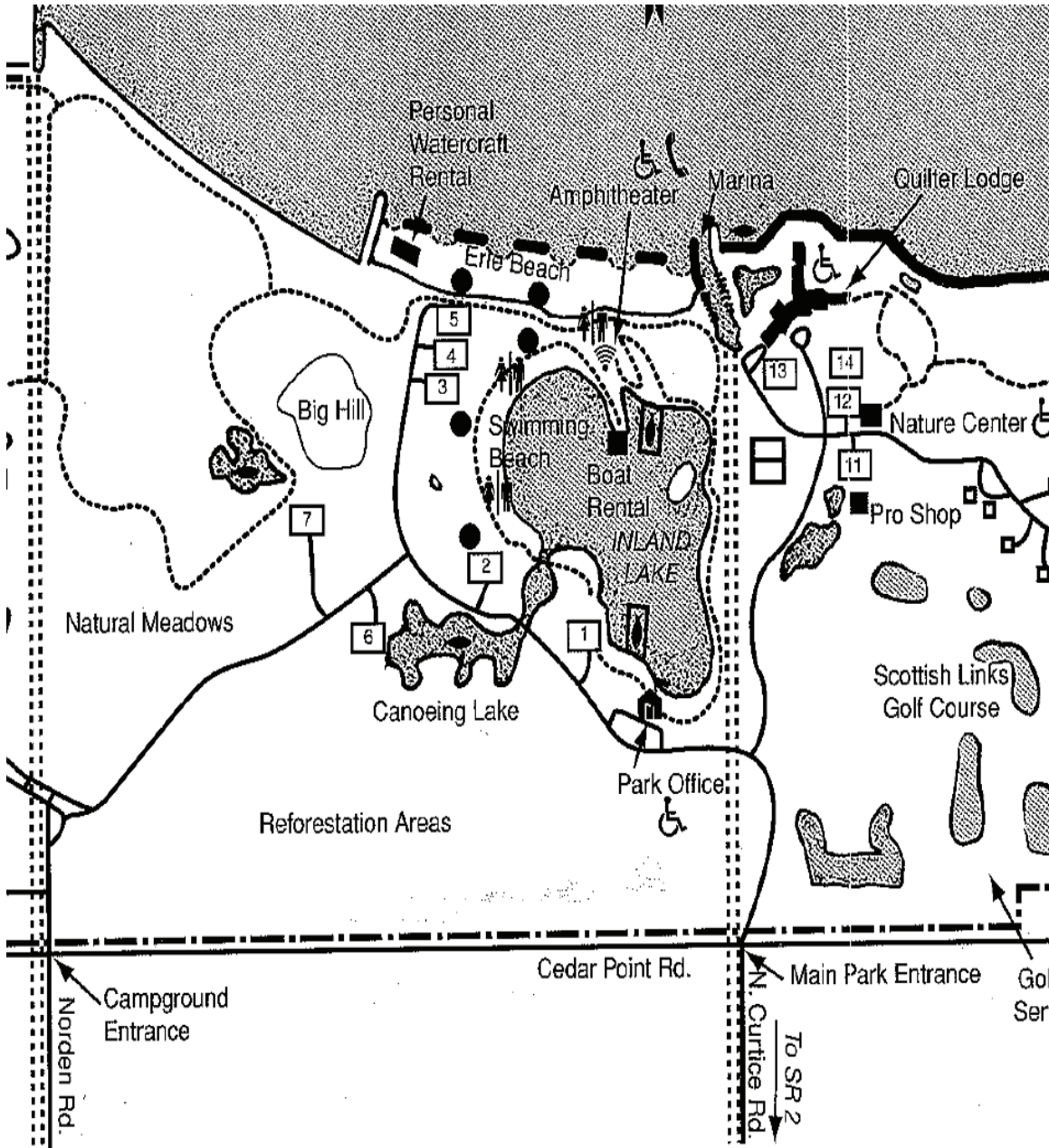
